# **Girls Dress Guidelines**

## **General Appearance**

- Hair must be clean, neatly styled, and traditionally feminine.
- No non-traditional hair colors.
- Earrings limited to two per earlobe; no other body piercings allowed.
- Discreet makeup permitted for grades 6–12 only. No dark lipstick or nail polish.
- No hats or hoodies in school buildings.
- Only full-zip jackets or sweaters allowed:
  - o Grades K4–5: Light, full-zip jackets only (no winter coats or hoodies).
  - o Grades 6–12: Only HCA full-zip jackets (from hcagear.com) or any cardigan.

## **School Uniform**

### **Polo Shirts**

- Long or short sleeves, solid colors only.
- Must be loose-fitting and tucked in at all times.
- Undershirts must also be solid-colored.
- One **orange polo** is required for **Chapel Wednesdays**.

#### **Bottoms**

- Skirts/Jumpers (girls):
  - o Navy, black, or khaki.
  - o Loose-fitting and must touch the knee when sitting or standing.
  - Slits must not be higher than the knee.
  - o Polo dresses acceptable if loose and knee-length.
  - o Solid leggings (ankle-length only) may be worn underneath.
  - o K4–5th must wear shorts under skirts/jumpers.
- Pants (boys and girls):
  - o Navy, black, or khaki.
  - o Must be loose-fitting; no skinny, jogger, cropped, capri, or denim styles.
  - Leggings/jeggings not permitted as pants.
  - o Pants with belt loops must be worn with a black or brown belt.

### Footwear

- Casual or athletic shoes required (athletic shoes mandatory for P.E.).
- No open-toed shoes, sandals, flip-flops, Crocs, or slippers.
- Socks must be worn at all times.

## **Special Events Attire (Grades 6-12)**

- Girls must purchase a pre-approved dress from an official list.
  - Dresses must be loose-fitting, non-transparent, with necklines no lower than two fingers below the collarbone.

- A dress check is conducted in the first quarter.
- o Failure to comply disqualifies participation in school functions.
- o Parents are responsible for ensuring dresses fit throughout the year.
- Choir/Event Participation:
  - Students graded on attendance, dress code adherence, and performance.
  - o Events may include Christmas Program, AACS Competition, or Awards Ceremony.
  - o No make-up grades are provided for missed events.

## P.E. Uniform (Grades 1-11)

- Grades 1-5:
  - o Official Student Shirt from hcagear.com (also used for field trips).
  - o Loose-fitting shorts that touch the kneecap (sitting or standing).
  - o Athletic pants allowed (must be loose-fitting and non-tapered).
  - o No joggers, leggings, or yoga pants.
  - o Non-marking athletic shoes required.
- Grades 6-11:
  - Custom P.E. shirt and shorts provided and billed via FACTS.
  - Optional second set available.
  - o Non-marking athletic shoes required.

## **Spirit Fridays**

- Students may wear an HCA t-shirt, sweatshirt, hoodie, or jersey from hcagear.com, or one issued/sanctioned by the school.
- All other uniform rules still apply.

## **Athletics Practice Attire (Grades 6-12)**

- Must wear designated 'Athletics' practice shirt and shorts (same style as P.E. uniform).
- Required per Student Athlete Agreement.

# **Boys Dress Guidelines**

## **General Appearance**

- Hair must be neat, clean, and traditionally masculine:
  - o At least 1 inch above eyebrows.
  - Trimmed above the ears and off the collar.
  - o Evenly tapered with no designs or attention-drawing styles.
  - o Non-traditional cuts and coloring are prohibited.
- No facial hair; secondary students must be clean-shaven.
- No earrings or jewelry (e.g., necklaces, bracelets).
- All shirts must be tucked in with belts clearly visible.
- No hats or hoodies in school buildings.
- Only full-zip jackets or sweaters allowed:
  - o Grades K4–5: Light, full-zip jackets only (no winter coats or hoodies).
  - o Grades 6–12: Only **HCA** full-zip jackets (from hcagear.com) or any cardigan.

## **School Uniform**

## **Polo Shirts**

- Long or short sleeves, solid colors only.
- Must be loose-fitting and tucked in at all times.
- Undershirts must also be solid-colored.
- One **orange polo** is required for **Chapel Wednesdays**.

## **Pants**

- Navy, black, or khaki.
- Must be loose-fitting; no skinny, jogger, or denim pants.
- Must have belt loops and be worn with a black or brown belt.

## Special Events Attire (Grades 6-12)

- Required to purchase an HCA tie for \$15 (replacements \$25; rental \$10).
- Billed via FACTS.
- Must adhere to school standards for neat, modest formalwear.
- Choir/Event Participation:
  - o Students graded on attendance, dress code adherence, and performance.
  - o Events may include Christmas Program, AACS Competition, or Awards Ceremony.
  - o No make-up grades are provided for missed events.

## P.E. Uniform (Grades 1-11)

- Grades 1-5:
  - o Official Student Shirt from hcagear.com (also used for field trips).
  - o Loose-fitting shorts that touch the kneecap (sitting or standing).
  - Athletic pants allowed (must be loose-fitting and non-tapered).
  - o No joggers, leggings, or yoga pants.

- Non-marking athletic shoes required.
- Grades 6-11:
  - o Custom P.E. shirt and shorts provided and billed via FACTS.
  - Optional second set available.

# **Athletics Practice Attire (Grades 6–12)**

- Must wear designated 'Athletics' practice shirt and shorts (same style as P.E. uniform).
- Required per Student Athlete Agreement.

# **Spirit Fridays**

- Students may wear an HCA t-shirt, sweatshirt, hoodie, or jersey.
- All other uniform rules still apply.

## Footwear

- Casual or athletic shoes required (athletic shoes mandatory for P.E.).
- No open-toed shoes, sandals, flip-flops, Crocs, or slippers.
- Socks must be worn at all times.
